Items of Business:

Digital Citizenship Presentation: Vice Principal Tuttle presented the council with some examples:

- a. Beginning of the year tech procedures with students
- b. Cell phones and ear pods not allowed to be used in school
- c. Chrome books only to be used in class

Safe Routes presentation: Vice Principal Tuttle explained that he was waiting for further information and would present that information in a future meeting.

Positive Behavior Intervention: Vice Principal Tuttle gave examples being used at Dixie Intermediate:

- a. Soar store: builds positive behavior by giving extrinsic rewards
- b. Rewards for attendance
- c. Student of the month club

Review of Trust Lands funding use for 25-26 school year: Principal Roden

Principal Roden discussed with council how the Trustland monies are being used to continue funding Language Arts and Math teachers to help keep class sizes and support math and reading classes.

Other items of business as needed from council:

Council discussed how parents could help with activities other than PTA. Mrs. Roden gave them information about the school pantry and how it helps many students at Dixie Intermediate. Council members would like parents to have the opportunity to volunteer in the food pantry

Current School Goals:

- a. Increase student ownership by using the learning process and focusing on analysis of student work.
- b. Increase student literacy by 100 lexile points.
- c. Increase student proficiency and grow scores through classroom engagement.

Suggested goals for 26-27:

- a. Parent volunteers for School Pantry
- b. Rotating books for One Book One School to save on costs
- c. Parent donations for School Soar Store
